

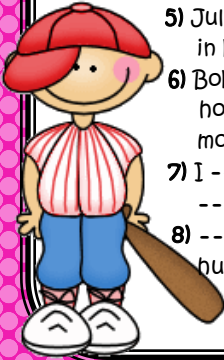

Zero Conditional

- If you ----- (mix) blue and yellow, you ----- (get) green.
- If you ----- (put) a coin in water, it ----- (sink).
- It ----- (evaporate) if you ----- (boil) water.
- If you ----- (put) a cork in the water it ----- (float).
- If you ----- (wait) under the sun too long you ----- (get) tanned.
- If you ----- (pour) oil in the water the oil ----- (float).
- It ----- (bleed) if you ----- (cut) your finger.



First Conditional

Second Conditional

- If I ----- (be) Tom I ----- (play) football.
- If Sally ----- (work) harder she ----- (pass) her exams.
