# **Conditionals : 1st. Conditional**

## A. USE:

We use the first conditional to talk about the result of a possible future action. (We do an action (present) and this action will have a good or a bad consequence in the future)

### **B.** FORM:

If- clause (condition)	Main clause (result)
IF + PRESENT SIMPLE	WILL/WON'T + INFINITIVE

Examples: If you go to university ( ) you will find a good job.

We always put comma between the condition and the result.

The order can change: You will find a good job if you go to university.

We can also use might and may in the main clause (both of them are used for predictions.

EX. If I get a good degree, I might apply to work in Microsoft.
