
Passive voice "questions"



WH-questions

<u>WH question</u> or <u>HOW</u> + <u>AUXILIARY VERB</u> + <u>SUBJECT</u> + <u>(be/ been / being</u>) + PAST PARTICIPLE:

- Let's consider the following examples:
 - 1- **How** do the photographers take these photos?

 <u>How are these photos taken</u> (by the photographers)
 - 2- Why have you stolen this vase? Why has this vase been stolen?
 - 3- Why were you wearing such a dress? Why was such a dress being worn?
 - 4- How can you fix this car engine?

 How can this car engine be fixed?

YES / NO QUESTIONS:

<u>AUXILIARY VERB</u> + <u>SUBJECT</u> + (<u>be/ been/ being</u>) + <u>PAST PARTICIPLE</u> ?

- Let's consider the following examples:
- 1- Did you answer the question?
 Was the question answered?
- 2- Had anybody seen the results?
 Had the results been seen?
- 3- Is John writing a report?

 <u>Is a report being written</u> (by John)
- 4- Can she imitate this actress?

 Can this actress be imitated?
